PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has more than 19,000 licensed amateur radio operators who have demonstrated their value in public assistance by providing emergency radio and public service communications; and

WHEREAS, volunteer amateur radio operators provide excellent emergency communications for numerous state and federal agencies in times of natural disasters and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, by example, and sharing practical experience, amateur radio operators are able to educate young people about many of the opportunities available in radio and electronics; and

WHEREAS, these amateur radio operators are on alert for any emergency and practice their communications skills during the American Radio Relay League's Field Day exercise; and

WHEREAS, this event is a 24-hour emergency preparedness exercise and demonstration of the amateur radio operators' skills and readiness to provide self-supporting communications without further infrastructure being required;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim June 22-28, 2024 as

Amateur Radio Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
