PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the National Guard Association of Tennessee (NGATN) is celebrating 100 years of promoting and supporting our national defense, the welfare of Tennessee National Guard members, and stronger relationships between the public and the National Guard; and

WHEREAS, NGATN advocates for the wellbeing of Tennessee National Guard members and their families while also building strong relationships between service members, civic leaders, and defense industry representatives to ensure the safety and defense of all Tennesseans; and

WHEREAS, since 1924, NGATN has helped promote legislative initiatives, at both the State and Federal level, which improved the quality of life for Soldiers and Airmen while improving the security and defense of Tennessee, our fellow states, and the nation; and

WHEREAS, since 1966, the NGATN Group Insurance Trust has provided life insurance coverage to over 150,000 Guard families and provided insurance claim payments totaling over \$20 million to families of fallen Soldiers and Airmen; and

WHEREAS, since 2017, the NGATN Foundation has provided benevolence support to members of the Tennessee National Guard, as well as college scholarship's amounting to over \$300,000 to members and their families; and

WHEREAS, since 2002, the NGATN has been supported by the Officers and Warrant Officers of the Tennessee National Guard, as evidenced by 100% enrollment in the Association; and

WHEREAS, we acknowledge the long history of NGATN and its contributions and achievements to our state and military members and families; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby designate February 24, 2024 as a Day of Recognition to honor the

100th Anniversary of the Founding of the National Guard Association of Tennessee

and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
