PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, hypertension, also known as high blood pressure, affects nearly half of all adults in the United States and is a leading risk factor for various cardiovascular diseases; and

WHEREAS, hypertension often goes undetected and untreated, leading to severe health complications, including heart disease, stroke, and kidney failure, and contributed to nearly 700,000 deaths in the United States in 2021; and

WHEREAS, only about one in four adults in the United States have their hypertension under control; Whereas, healthcare costs in the United States associated with hypertension account for about \$131 billion per year, while individuals with hypertension are estimated to face nearly \$2,000 higher annual healthcare expenditures compared to those without hypertension; and

WHEREAS, early detection, proper management, and access to medical treatments are critical to reducing the prevalence and impact of hypertension on individuals' health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, the month of May is dedicated to raising awareness about hypertension, promoting education about prevention and management, and encouraging individuals to monitor their blood pressure regularly; and

WHEREAS, access to affordable and quality healthcare services, including medical treatments, is crucial for managing hypertension and improving health outcomes; and

WHEREAS, community initiatives, healthcare professionals, and advocacy organizations play a vital role in educating the public, providing resources, and advocating for policies that enhance hypertension awareness and access to medical care;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim May 2024, as

Hypertension Hwareness Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
