PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Reading Is Fundamental (RIF) is a national children's literacy organization, providing children in need with access to and choice of high-quality books and enriching literacy resources and aims to transform lives through the power of books;

WHEREAS, RIF was founded in 1966 in Washington, DC and since then has distributed more than 412 million new, free books to 40 million children in need in communities nationwide;

WHEREAS, two-thirds of children living in poverty own no books and sixty-five percent of fourth graders read at or below the basic level;

WHEREAS, in 2015 alone, RIF distributed more than 80,820 books to children in need in the State of Tennessee and;

WHEREAS, RIF is celebrating its 50th anniversary and we take this opportunity to honor this organization's contributions to the families of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim September 14, 2016 as

Reading Is Fundamental Day

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
