WHEREAS, Tennessee is home to the Elephant Sanctuary, a non-profit organization dedicated to providing captive elephants with individualized care, the companionship of a herd, and a secure environment for these highly intelligent and emotional creatures; and

WHEREAS, in 2016 The Sanctuary is celebrating 21 years of having provided a safe haven and natural-habitat refuge dedicated solely to elephant wellbeing; and

WHEREAS, The Elephant Sanctuary continually sets and reaches goals to better the lives of all elephants worldwide;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, hereby proclaim the month of October, 2016 as

Elephant Awareness Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
