## PROCLAMATION

## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, on March 17, 1917, Civitan was formed as an independent service organization in Birmingham, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Civitan, coined from the Latin word civitas, means, "citizenship"; and

WHEREAS, "Builders of Good Citizenship" became the natural motto for the civic-minded group; and

WHEREAS, Civitan encourages clubs to seek and fill needs within their communities; and

WHEREAS, Knoxville Civitans helped pioneer the health focus raising \$100,000 to build a threestory hospital for indigent tuberculosis patients in 1923; and

WHEREAS, Developmental disabilities became the major organizational focus, which has led to the Civitan International Research Center at UAB in Birmingham, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the Civitan International Research Center has become a world leader in developmental disability research, along with major advances in the study of autism, Down syndrome, brain tumors, epilepsy, Alzheimer's, Lewy Body Dementia, among other afflictions;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim March 17, 2017 as
