# PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS**, April 6, 2017 has been designated National Apartment Housing Day by the National Apartment Association Education Institute and the Tennessee Apartment Association to highlight careers in residential property management; and

**WHEREAS**, rental housing serves the needs of approximately 35% of American households; and

**WHEREAS**, rental housing units are maintained by a dedicated team of skilled maintenance professionals; and

**WHEREAS**, community managers and leasing consultants are responsible for helping prospective residents find the right home that fits their budget and lifestyle, providing good customer services, managing risk and marketing the community to maintain a financially sound real estate asset; and

**WHEREAS**, to meet the challenges of a growing rental housing industry, new, skilled workers are needed to replace retiring workers and to staff newly built apartment communities; and

**WHEREAS**, through strategic partnerships with career academies, technical high schools, technical and community colleges, universities, workforce investment boards and veterans organizations, the National Apartment Association Education Institute and the Tennessee Apartment Association strive to ensure that people receive the necessary training to find new, portable and rewarding careers in apartment management so that residents of Tennessee can enjoy living in their apartment home and communities;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim April 6, 2017 as
