## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Confederate soldiers are remembered for their great loyalty to comradeship and country; and

WHEREAS, in lawful and dignified measures, the South sought an honorable separation, and with equally honorable acquiescence in its failure, re-entered the Union to defend its honor and maintain its glory forever; and

WHEREAS, all states should hold our government true to the landmarks which our forefathers have set;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim June 3, 2017 as

Confederate Decoration Day

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
