BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the people of Tennessee recognize the sacrifice of the members of our armed services and their families; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in defense of our freedom; and

WHEREAS, we remember the families who have lost their loved ones in combat; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Reece Gass of Greeneville, Tennessee, was killed on January 14, 1945 while serving his country in World War II; and

WHEREAS, Gass served with Company E, 33rd Armored Regiment, 3rd Armored Division in the United States Army; and

WHEREAS, Gass's remains will be returned to his native state and laid at rest in Greeneville, Tennessee on June 10, 2017; and

WHEREAS, we are grateful to finally welcome home this brave soldier who made the ultimate sacrifice for his country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim June 10, 2017 as a

Day of Mourning in Remembrance of Private First Class Reece Gass

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
