



STATE OF TENNESSEE
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, railroad-highway crossing crashes during the year 2016 resulted in 2 fatalities and 18 injuries within the state of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, pedestrian trespass incidents on railroad property during the year 2016 resulted in 8 fatalities and 12 injuries in the state of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, railroad-highway crossing crashes are usually more severe than highway collisions and are more likely to result in death and injury; and

WHEREAS, collisions at railroad-highway crossings may be prevented by increased public awareness of the dangers at crossings, the dangers of trespassing on railroad property, and the related safety laws, and

WHEREAS, Operation Lifesaver is a public information and education program dedicated to preventing railroad-highway crossing crashes and pedestrian/railroad trespass incidents; and

WHEREAS, on Sept. 24-30, 2017, and throughout the year, all citizens are encouraged to observe added caution as motorists or pedestrians near tracks or trains, and

WHEREAS, this important observance should lead to greater safety awareness and a reduction in railroad-highway crossing crashes and pedestrian/railroad incidents;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the week of September 24-30, 2017 as

Rail Safety Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
