PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the goal of Tennessee's Drive to 55 initiative is to increase the percentage of Tennesseans with a college degree or credentials to fifty-five percent by the year 2025; and

WHEREAS, in fall 2016, a record 38,698 high school seniors who graduated in 2016 enrolled in college; and

WHEREAS, CollegeforTN.org provides Tennesseans of all ages with the resources to prepare for college, choose the institution that best aligns with their career aspirations, and successfully meet the requirements of the college application process; and

WHEREAS, during the week of September 25-29, all Tennessee high school seniors are encouraged to submit an application to a postsecondary institution with the encouragement and assistance of school, college, and community volunteers; and

WHEREAS, during the week of September 25-29, all Tennessee students from kindergarten through high school are encouraged to explore the vast array of college options available to them;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim September 25-29, 2017, as

College Application and Exploration Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
