BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Tennessee recognizes the essential role that an effective and accountable system of education plays in preparing all children to be successful adults; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee has a multitude of high-quality traditional public schools, public magnet schools, public charter schools, and nonpublic schools, as well as families who educate their children in the home; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee has many high-quality, dedicated teaching professionals in all types of education environments; and

WHEREAS, it is important for parents in Tennessee to explore and identify the best education options available to their children; and

WHEREAS, research demonstrates that providing children with multiple education options improves academic performance; and

WHEREAS, School Choice Week is a national celebration recognized by millions of students, parents, educators, schools, and community leaders, for the purpose of raising public awareness of the importance of effective education options for children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim January 21-27, 2018 as

School Choice Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
