## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, these well-educated and highly-trained health professionals who perform and evaluate medical laboratory tests to detect, diagnose, monitor treatment, and help prevent diseases, save countless lives each day and laboratory test results comprise an estimated 70% of the patient's medical records; and

WHEREAS, with the public now demanding increased health care quality and professional accountability, organizations representing practitioners of this critical science have a responsibility to ensure that the public is well informed about clinical laboratory competency; and

WHEREAS, beyond meeting this public need, the celebration of NMLPW helps increase recognition for the profession as it improves the individual practitioner's sense of self-worth; and

WHEREAS, laboratory medicine is an honorable profession, vital to sustaining a high standard of health care;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the week of April 22-28, 2018
