BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, in 2012, TRICOR changed its mission statement, which now reads "To prepare offenders for success after release." in an effort to better serve its customers; and

WHEREAS, TRICOR programs provide on the job skills as well as cognitive behavior based training for more than 1,000 offenders annually; and

WHEREAS, TRICOR will continue to strive to reduce the costs of programming and supervision of incarcerated individuals by which saves Tennessee taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, TRICOR contributes to the safety of Tennesseans by helping offenders successfully reintegrate into society, reducing the potential for repeat crimes; and

WHEREAS, TRICOR provides Tennessee businesses with a well-trained workforce with reinforced soft skills; and

WHEREAS, TRICOR's hope is that it's vision, which is supported by the aforementioned work, that after successfully completing the TRICOR program no offender participant will return to prison, will permeate throughout all those that work for the agency;
