NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 2012, as

NATIVE AMERICAN INDIAN MONTH

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
