## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, President Nixon signed the Occupational Safety and Health Act into law on December 28, 1970, and

WHEREAS, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration was founded on April 28, 1971, and

WHEREAS, it is important to honor the men and women who have passed away or been injured on the job, and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Code Annotated § 15-1-101 requires the Governor to proclaim April 28 of each year as "Workers' Memorial Day";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim April 28, 2019 as

Workers' Memorial Day

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
