## PROCLAMATION

## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the people of Tennessee recognize the sacrifice of the members of our armed services and their families; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in defense of our freedom; and

WHEREAS, we remember the families who have lost their loved ones in combat; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class William Delaney of Kingston, Tennessee, then age 24, was killed on November 22, 1944 while serving his country in World War II; and

WHEREAS, Delaney served with Company A, 1st Battalion, 22nd Infantry Regiment, 4th Infantry Division; and

WHEREAS, his foxhole was struck by an enemy artillery shell when his battalion engaged with German defenders near Grosshau in the Hürtgen Forest; and

WHEREAS, his remains will be returned to his native state and laid at rest at Lawnville Cemetery in Kingston, Tennessee on May 27, 2019; and

WHEREAS, we are grateful to finally welcome home this brave soldier who made the ultimate sacrifice for his country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim May 26, 2019 as a
