## PROCLAMATION

## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, doctors of chiropractic (DCs) are doctoral-level providers who focus on the whole person in their conservative approach to pain management and health care, and have particular expertise in the prevention, care and rehabilitation of musculoskeletal injuries and conditions; and

WHEREAS, many adults in the United States report experiencing a musculoskeletal condition; and

WHEREAS, workplace overexertion injuries are estimated to cost \$15.1 billion a year and account for about 25% of the total workers' compensation cost in the U.S.1; and

WHEREAS, chiropractic care is widely recognized as a safe, conservative treatment for low back pain and

WHEREAS, the American College of Physicians low-back pain treatment guidelines released in 2017 promote the use of noninvasive, non-drug approaches such as spinal manipulation as performed by chiropractors, as a first line of defense against back pain, and groups such as the Centers for Disease Control, Federal Drug Administration and the Joint Commission also now promote the use of nonpharmacologic approaches first for pain management; and

WHEREAS, Doctors of chiropractic are recognized worldwide for their health and wellness enhancing and injury-prevention services which help people to heal naturally, without the need of unnecessary drugs and surgery, to resume their regular activities and achieve levels of optimal functioning; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Chiropractic Association has offered support to thousands of citizens employed in chiropractic across the state for 84 years for the benefit of millions of Tennesseans;

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Chiropractic Association joins with the American Chiropractic Association in recognizing the month of October 2019 as National Chiropractic Health Month;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim October 2019 as

Chiropractic Health Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
