WHEREAS, SFC Jeremy W. Griffin of Greenbrier, Tennessee, was killed on September 16, 2019 while serving his country during a combat deployment in Wardak Province, Afghanistan to support Operation Freedom's Sentinel; and

WHEREAS, Griffin was assigned to 3rd Battalion, 1st Special Forces Group (Airborne), Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington; and

WHEREAS, we are grateful to finally welcome home this brave soldier who made the ultimate sacrifice for his country;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim October 5, 2019 as a

Day of Mourning in Remembrance of SFC Jeremy W. Griffin

and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
