BY THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS**, the debt our fallen warriors and their families make is one for which our country can never return or sufficiently express our gratitude, for in their sacrifice, Americans enjoy the freedom and liberty on which our country was founded; and

**WHEREAS**, we recognize the sacrifice that every Gold Star Family has made and will continue to make, living each day with the memory of their loved one in their thought; and

**WHEREAS**, we pray for peace and comfort to come to their hearts as they know that we have etched the name of their fallen Soldier, Marine, Sailor, Airman or Coast Guardsman in our hearts with them; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Tennessee are encouraged to display the flag and hold appropriate ceremonies as a public expression of our Nation's gratitude and respect for our Gold Star Families;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim May 22, 2020 as
