



STATE OF TENNESSEE
PROCLAMATION
BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the Governor's Early Literacy Foundation (GELF) strengthens early literacy in Tennessee by acting as a thought leader, advisor and catalyst to sustain early literacy programs for children statewide; and

WHEREAS, less than half of Tennessee's third graders read proficiently; and

WHEREAS, third grade reading proficiency is the benchmark where children transition from "learning to read" to "reading to learn," a key indicator for a child's future educational success and workforce readiness; and

WHEREAS, GELF works to strengthen this in Tennessee by providing children with the resources, guidance and support they need to build early literacy skills and become lifelong learners from cradle to career; and

WHEREAS, through which, Tennessee children have access to early literacy programs statewide, including Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, Storybook Trails, Book Buses, Caregiver Engagement and K-3 Summer Reading; and

WHEREAS, the not-for-profit GELF - in partnership with Dolly Parton's Imagination Library and the Dollywood Foundation - provides one high-quality, age-appropriate book every month mailed to enrolled children from birth to age five, at no cost to families and regardless of income; and

WHEREAS, GELF partners with a network of volunteers, donors and organizations to provide Storybook Trails, Book Buses, Caregiver Engagement and K-3 Summer Reading programs to further engage families around reading and to continue to provide children with literacy resources; and

WHEREAS, GELF's work is made financially possible through a unique use of public, private and corporate funding; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of Tennessee's Early Literacy Month will provide communities and programs across the state an opportunity to fundraise and increase awareness of the importance of early literacy and resources available to children through Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, Storybook Trails, Book Buses, Caregiver Engagement and K-3 Summer Reading programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, and Maria Lee, First Lady of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the month of September 2020 as

Early Literacy Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
