PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Supreme Court Rule 31 was enacted in January 1996 to establish court-based alternative dispute resolution on a statewide basis; and

WHEREAS, as a result of promulgation of Supreme Court Rule 31, there are now over a thousand Rule 31 mediators in Tennessee: and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee legislature supports ten state-funded Victim Offender Reconciliation Program centers; and

WHEREAS, mediation in Tennessee continues to grow and assist citizens and the courts in alternative dispute resolution; and

WHEREAS, governmental entities across the United States and around the world are proclaiming October 20, 2011 as an official day of recognition for conflict resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim October 2011 as

MEDIATION MONTH

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
