WHEREAS, the children's home has served as a home away from home for over 33,000 children and young people; and

WHEREAS, the date of December 17, 2020 marks the 100th Anniversary of the Smoky Mountain Children's Home;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim December 17, 2020 as

Smoky Mountain Children's Home Day

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in congratulating them for a century of service to children and youth.
