BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, autistic Tennesseans have the same rights, needs, and dreams as all Tennesseans, but continue to face barriers to full acceptance and participation in the world around them; and

WHEREAS, our state is stronger when all citizens have the services and supports they need to be fully included, contributing members of their communities; and

WHEREAS, we recognize the value of every person and commit to a culture of acceptance and celebration of every individual;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim April 2021 as

Hutism Acceptance Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
