**PROCLAMATION**  
BY THE GOVERNOR

**WHEREAS**, Heterotaxy Syndrome is a congenital condition that affects the development, placement and presence of internal organs; and

**WHEREAS**, the public is largely unaware of Heterotaxy Syndrome; and

**WHEREAS**, Heterotaxy Syndrome affects many body systems and requires a team of many specialists for treatment; and

**WHEREAS**, Mortality for those with Heterotaxy Syndrome is relatively high; and

**WHEREAS**, those with Heterotaxy Syndrome that survive to adulthood find their condition largely unknown to their community; and

**WHEREAS**, Heterotaxy Syndrome Awareness Day provides an opportunity for families whose lives have been affected to celebrate life and to remember loved ones lost, to honor dedicated health professionals, and to meet others and to know they are not alone; and

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of Heterotaxy Syndrome Awareness Day will also provide the opportunity to share experience and information with the public and the media, in order to raise public awareness about Heterotaxy Syndrome;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim May 4, 2021 as

*Heterotaxy Awareness Day*

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
