PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, beef is Tennessee's second highest grossing farm commodity generating over 14 percent of the state's \$3.4 billion agricultural cash receipts; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee ranks 9th in the nation for number of farms and 16th in the nation for cattle production with approximately 1.8 million head cattle and calves, and

WHEREAS, the state of Tennessee recognizes the important contributions of our state's 37,000 cattle producers; and

WHEREAS, cattle are among the most efficient means of converting forage to human food on Tennessee's over 5 million acres of pasture and hay and thereby contribute to the conservation of soil by allowing those acres to remain in grass and legumes; and

WHEREAS, beef provides a valuable source of high-quality protein, as well as numerous vitamins and minerals important to a healthful diet; and

WHEREAS, the state of Tennessee recognizes the economic and nutritional value of beef production and beef consumption to the enjoyment and good health of our citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim July 2021 as

Beef Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
