PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Keep Tennessee Beautiful is the state-level affiliate of Keep America Beautiful and has served as a state resource center for litter prevention, community greening, and recycling & waste reduction education since 1983; and

WHEREAS, Keep Tennessee Beautiful is housed by the University of Memphis as an independent department within the College of Professional & Liberal Studies as a community engagement program; and

WHEREAS, the spirit of volunteerism is alive and well in Tennessee and we value citizen participation in community improvement projects such as the Great American Cleanup that takes place throughout our 95 counties; and

WHEREAS, last year during the Great American Cleanup, approximately 29,000 Tennessee volunteers donated over 203,000 hours to collect almost 1.5 million pounds of litter and 615,000 pounds of recycling along nearly 340 miles of roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim March, 2022 as

Keep Tennessee Beautiful Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
