## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, thousands of Tennesseans continue this time-honored tradition of volunteerism through service as volunteer firefighters in their communities; and

WHEREAS, these individuals daily face the rigors of corporal imperilment in protecting those whom they so selflessly serve; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee's fire departments, and volunteer firefighters, are dedicated to saving lives and property from the devastating effects of fire and are joined by the concerned citizens and government officials of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of those brave men and women who have put their lives on the line while fighting fires, and those who have lost that battle to save and protect their fellow citizens, the state of Tennessee is proud to dedicate a special week to remember and honor these fire heroes; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated 15-2-121 requires that the Governor proclaim the first full week of March of each year as "Volunteer Firefighters Week";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the week of March 6-12, 2022 as

Volunteer Firefighters Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
