BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, SATB2 Associated Syndrome (SAS) is a rare genetic condition affecting approximately 650 individuals around the world; and

WHEREAS, while each SAS individual is different, they share several common attributes including -- but not limited to -- developmental delays, speech delays, intellectual delay, dental malformations, behavior issues; and

WHEREAS, while this diagnosis is not common, more individuals are being diagnosed than ever because of the research and studies being done and shared across the globe; and

WHEREAS, there are 6 known cases of SAS in the state of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, by working to raise awareness of this rare genetic syndrome, this day is meant to celebrate these families and spread the word so others longing for a diagnosis may be found;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim August 22, 2022, as
