PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, highway-grade crossing crashes during the year 2021 resulted in 4 fatalities and another 8 injured in the state of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, pedestrian/railroad trespass incidents on railroad property during the year 2021 resulted in 10 fatalities and another 11 injured in the state of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, highway-grade crossing crashes are more severe than highway collisions and are more likely to result in death and injury; and

WHEREAS, collisions between trains and motor vehicles or pedestrians can be prevented by increased public awareness of the dangers at crossings and around railroad property, and of the appropriate safety laws, and

WHEREAS, Operation Lifesaver is a public information and education program dedicated to preventing highway-rail grade crossing crashes and pedestrian/railroad trespass incidents; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the week of September 19-25, 2022, as

Rail Safety Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
