PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Geography Awareness Week promotes geo-literacy and education in the nation's schools and communities, which is an essential part of a twenty-first century education, and has been a congressionally-mandated week since 1987; and

WHEREAS, teachers, students, and communities across Tennessee will gain further understanding about how our world is made up of interconnected human and natural systems using resources developed by the National Geographic Society and other committed organizations during Geography Awareness Week and throughout the school year;
