## PROCLAMATION

## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the Great American Cleanup which was established by Keep America Beautiful, Inc., is the nation's largest annual community improvement program involving over 3.4 million volunteers; and

WHEREAS, Keep Tennessee Beautiful, a department of The University of Memphis, and is a state affiliate of Keep America Beautiful; and

WHEREAS, last year during the Great American Cleanup approximately 29,000 Tennesseans, spanning all 95 counties, volunteered to collect nearly 1.3 million pounds of litter and over 130,000 pounds of recycling; and

WHEREAS, since 1983 Keep Tennessee Beautiful has served as a state resource center for litter prevention, community greening, and recycling & waste reduction education; and

WHEREAS, the spirit of volunteerism is alive and well in Tennessee and we value citizen participation in community improvement projects;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim March 2023 as

Keep Tennessee Beautiful Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
