WHEREAS, internal auditors are independent professionals who identify and manage risks, provide assurance for compliance with laws, regulations, and policies, and address instances of organizational fraud, waste, and abuse; and

WHEREAS, The Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA), the internal audit profession's most widely recognized advocate, educator, and provider of standards, guidance, and certifications, celebrates its 82nd anniversary in 2023; and

WHEREAS, Internal Audit Awareness Month presents an opportunity to recognize, acknowledge, and commend the efforts and contributions of internal auditors in corporations, not-for-profit organizations, and in state and local governments throughout the great state of Tennessee;
