BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, today's highly specific, complex, and costly medications require more intensive attention and education to help emphasize the value of proper compliance; and

WHEREAS, any extraordinary healthcare challenge further highlights the indispensable role of pharmacists in public health emergencies, including vaccination efforts, provision of accurate information, and maintaining medication access; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee acknowledges the importance of promoting public awareness about the vital role that pharmacists play in delivering quality healthcare to our communities;
