## PROCLAMATION

## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Neuromyelitis Optica Spectrum. Disorder (NMOSD) is a rare and relatively unknown autoimmune disease that currently has no cure; and

WHEREAS, NMOSD attacks the central nervous system and can cause permanent disability, including blindness and/or paralysis; and

WHEREAS, the cause of NMOSD is still a mystery and there are few approved treatments; and

WHEREAS, when mistaken for other diseases, treatments can exacerbate NMOSD symptoms; and

WHEREAS, the NMOSD community is dedicated to increasing awareness and understanding of this disease in order to promote research, improved patient care, and outcomes, and ultimately a cure;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim March 2024 as

Neuromyelitis Optica Hwareness Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
