PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, oral health impacts overall health, and good oral health is essential to a healthy life, and when we practice good oral health habits, we increase our smiles; and

WHEREAS, smiles are morale boosters and confidence builders, and when you smile at someone, you communicate that they are valued and worth the smile that you just gave them; and

WHEREAS, we encourage Tennesseans to care for their health by brushing their teeth in the morning, after meals, and at night before bed; and

WHEREAS, tooth decay is the most common chronic condition of childhood, and poor oral health can have a detrimental effect on children's quality of life, their performance at school, and their success later in life (CDC); and

WHEREAS, nearly half of all adults aged 30 years or older show signs of gum disease (CDC); and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Charitable Care Network (TCCN), with a mission to provide support, education, and representation for non-profit organizations that provide charitable health care services to low-income, uninsured, and underserved Tennesseans strives to increase access to affordable oral health services for all Tennesseans in need; and

WHEREAS, of TCCN's 56+ charitable care member locations, 20 members in 19 locations provide direct oral health services, and TCCN's five Project Access members coordinate referrals for free or reduced-cost complex oral care; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee's charitable and safety net dental clinics provided 48,555 oral health services to 31,631 unique patients in 2023; and

WHEREAS, these more than 31,000 Tennesseans would otherwise not have received care; and

WHEREAS, TCCN charitable care providers know that restoring a healthy smile can completely turn someone's life around; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim June 10-14, 2024, as

"Smile Power" Oral Health Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
