PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, older Tennesseans are valued members of our communities, who deserve to be treated with respect and dignity to enable them to live safely, independently, to serve as leaders, mentors and volunteers; and

WHEREAS, elder abuse is any act that harms an older person or jeopardizes his or her health or welfare, is a tragedy inflicted on vulnerable older Tennesseans and is an ever-increasing problem that crosses all socio-economic boundaries; and

WHEREAS, 2024 marks the 18th Annual World Elder Abuse Awareness Day (WEAAD), representing the one day in the year when the entire world focuses on elder abuse, one of the most unrecognized, underreported and unaddressed issues facing older, vulnerable adults; and

WHEREAS, since 2016, the Tennessee State Coordinated Community Response (State CCR), has been led by the Adult Protective Services Program of the Tennessee Department of Human Services and comprised of 20 state agencies and 9 regional representatives, who are committed to the prevention of elder abuse, improving the investigation, response, and delivery of protective services to older and vulnerable adults by Tennessee State Agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee District Attorneys General Conference spearheaded the drafting, enactment, and implementation of a series of Public Acts to more clearly define and more effectively deter neglect, abuse, financial exploitation and harm to our elder population; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Office of Criminal Justice Programs provides funding to the Tennessee Department of Human Services and local non-profits to assist older and vulnerable victims of crime to restore a sense of safety in their lives, to provide advocacy for their needs; to support them through the court process and to assist with their healing as a result of their victimization;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee do hereby proclaim June 15, 2024 as

Elder Abuse Awareness Day

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
