PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, case managers function in a variety of practice settings including hospitals, home healthcare, long-term care, rehabilitation facilities, eldercare, managed care, occupational health and primary care to facilitate timely and efficient coordination of care through each transition of healthcare services; and

WHEREAS, case management is the primary medical management strategy that fosters the careful shepherding of healthcare dollars while maintaining a primary and consistent focus on patient advocacy; and

WHEREAS, case management interventions and services enhance quality of life while advancing the achievement of positive healthcare outcomes; and

WHEREAS, case management is an integral component of healthcare delivery in Tennessee and throughout the United States;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim October 13-19, 2024 as

Case Management Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
