WHEREAS, school psychologists are trained to assess school-based barriers to learning and individual strengths, use data-based decision-making, evaluate outcomes and improve accountability; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee recognizes the vital role that school psychologists can play in the personal and academic development of our children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim November 11-15, 2024, as

School Psychology Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
