PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, road construction and road maintenance, performed by construction workers, utility personnel, and maintenance workers, play an essential role in our ability to be a mobile and free nation; and

WHEREAS, work zones present a challenge and potential danger to all motorists, and improvements in safety, education, and driver behavior will benefit drivers of all ages; and

WHEREAS, 1,021 traffic fatalities occurred on Tennessee's roads and highways in 2012; and

WHEREAS, there were 2,711 traffic crashes in Tennessee work zones in 2012; and

WHEREAS, twelve people lost their lives in work zone crashes in Tennessee in 2012; and

WHEREAS, three workers were killed in work zones in 2012; and

WHEREAS, the most frequently occurring contributing factor to motor vehicle wrecks in construction zones are careless driving, speeding, and failure to obey signs and traffic controls; and

WHEREAS, the majority of crashes occur in longer term construction zones, with more than half of them during the day, and 60% on non-interstate roads posted for 55 mph or higher; and

WHEREAS, more than half of work zone crashes involve a single vehicle, and one in five involves a heavy truck; and

WHEREAS, roadway construction workers are killed at a rate nearly three times higher than construction workers in other areas, and eight times higher than general industry workers; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Department of Transportation and the Tennessee Department of Safety make consistent and numerous efforts to improve safety in work zones and all roadways in Tennessee through use of enforcement and education, and communications tools such as Tennessee 511, TDOT SmartWay and the TDOT SmartWay Mobile App; and

WHEREAS, these services provide the citizens of Tennessee with the knowledge they need to safely travel through work zones, protecting themselves as well as the men and women who put their lives at risk each day in work zones across the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the week of April 14-20, 2013 as

National Work Zone Hwareness Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
