PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Goodwill sells donated goods to provide employment and training opportunities for people who have disabilities and others who have trouble finding and keeping jobs; and

WHEREAS, Goodwill Industries is one of Tennessee's largest employers of persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, in 2012, Goodwill Industries served thousands of Tennesseans through Career Solutions, a program that provides free job training and placement services; and

WHEREAS, during Goodwill Week last year, Goodwill Industries helped more than 2,000 people in their job search by holding 28 events including 14 job fairs; and

WHEREAS, during Goodwill Week this year, Goodwill Industries will hold approximately 45 events, including approximately 30 job fairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the week of May 5-11, 2013, as

Goodwill Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
