PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, family members steadfastly supported our nation while playing a vital role of support in the commitment, readiness and well-being of their loved ones who served in our United States Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, traditionally, Gold Star Mothers and Gold Star Wives are deservingly recognized and honored throughout our Nation on their special remembrance days; and

WHEREAS, it is also essential that we gather around all family members who have lost loved ones in our military services to show our compassion, offer assistance with seemingly insurmountable issues, give hope to help mend their broken hearts, and inspire them to strive for courage and strength to grow; and

WHEREAS, while we remember our Airmen, Marines, Sailors and Soldiers who served and died for our freedom, let us remember and pay tribute to the fathers, husbands, children and other family members left behind who also paid an immeasurable price;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim May 24, 2013, as

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
