BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, online services also allow you to apply for benefits, appeal a decision, find out if you qualify for benefits, and estimate your future benefits; and

WHEREAS, The Social Security Administration provides online services and program information to nearly 141 million visitors to their internet site www.SocialSecurity.gov; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the Social Security Administration celebrates its 79th anniversary of the signing of the Social Security Act; and

WHEREAS, to this day, the Social Security Administration remains true to its vision to "Provide the highest standard of considerate and thoughtful service for generations to come;"

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the week of June 9-13, 2014 as
