## PROCLAMATION

## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, beef is Tennessee's number one farm commodity generating more than twenty percent of the state's \$3.8 billion in agricultural cash receipts; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee ranks 9<sup>th</sup> nationally in the total number of farms and 15<sup>th</sup> in beef cattle production with more than 1.9 million head of cattle and calves; and

WHEREAS, the state of Tennessee recognizes the important contributions of our state's 48,000 cattle producers as good stewards of private land and resources, and as business and community leaders; and

WHEREAS, cattle are among the most efficient means of converting forage to human food on Tennessee's five million acres of pasture and hay lands; thereby contributing to the conservation of soil by allowing those acres to remain in grass and legumes; and

WHEREAS, beef provides a valuable source of high quality protein, as well as numerous vitamins and minerals important to a balanced, healthy diet; and

WHEREAS, the state of Tennessee recognizes the economic and nutritional value of beef promotion and beef consumption to the enjoyment and good health of our citizens;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the month of July, 2014, as

Beef Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
