WHEREAS, Nashville is the host city to the National Women's Survivors Convention, which brings thousands of survivors to Tennessee for education, motivation and life application of survivorship related issues; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee is uniquely suited to be the inviting, healing, hospitable destination to welcome women survivors, co-survivors, and caregivers from all over the world during the second annual National Women's Survivors Convention, July 27 through August 2, 2014 in Nashville, Tennessee;
