## PROCLAMATION

## BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Tennessee families recognize that a college education is one of the most important things we can do for our children to prepare them for success in life; and

WHEREAS, the quality of life for Tennessee is driven by a well-educated citizenry; and

WHEREAS, without proper planning, the inherent high cost of post-secondary education can prohibit a family's ability to ensure their children have access to higher education; and

WHEREAS, an earnings gap exists between those with a high school diploma and those with a bachelor's degree or beyond that exceeds \$1 million over a lifetime; and

WHEREAS, student loan debt has surpassed \$1.2 trillion, with loan programs composing a substantial amount of the funds on which students rely to finance higher education; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Tennessee families to encourage saving for higher education expenses so that access to educational opportunities is enhanced for Tennessee children, grandchildren and others; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has created the TNStars College Savings 529 Program, which offers federal income tax benefits and cash incentives to Tennessee residents to encourage saving; and

WHEREAS, all Tennesseans should consider the benefit of saving for college using a TNStars account;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim September 2014 as

College Savings Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
