BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, October 19-25, 2014 is the 18th annual National Massage Therapy Awareness Week as recognized by the American Massage Therapy Association; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee currently has more than 4,300 licensed massage therapists; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee has recognized and regulated massage therapists as an important part of the health industry for nearly two decades; and

WHEREAS, research continues to show that massage can be an effective part of pain management for a variety of patients; and

WHEREAS, Americans are turning to massage therapy in increasing numbers for relief from injuries and certain conditions, both acute and chronic, to help them deal with the stresses of daily life, and to maintain good health;
