PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the meetings industry contributed more than \$280 billion to the national economy and put another \$88 billion back into the economy through federal, state and local taxes in 2012; and

WHEREAS, hosting an event, convention, or tradeshow stimulates this region's economy by bringing in new visitors who stay in our hotels, eat in our restaurants, shop in neighborhood stores and bring new revenue; and

WHEREAS, Meetings Industry Day is a time for Tennesseans to reflect on the importance of the meetings industry and what it has provided for our state; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Society of Association Executives promotes and celebrates the meetings industry across the state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim April 16, 2015 as
