PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, there are more than 14 million cancer survivors in America; and

WHEREAS, A cancer diagnosis is a life game changer and survivors face long term and lifelimiting effects of the illness and its treatments, including physical, emotional, psychosocial, legal, and financial issues; and

WHEREAS, The Women Survivors Alliance, founded in the State of Tennessee, has undertaken a national call to action to address the burdens of survivorship issues on women, their family, and by extension, society as a whole; and

WHEREAS, Nashville is the host city to SURVIVORville 2015, held on June 5th and 6th, and National Cancer Survivors Day on June 7th, which brings survivors to Music City for education, motivation and life application of survivorship related issues; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee is uniquely suited to be the inviting, healing, hospitable destination to welcome survivors and co-survivors from around the world during these important events;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim June 1-7, 2015 as

Cancer Survivors Week

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
