PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, Arachnoiditis, is a debilitating, progressive, multi-symptom, neurological disease caused by inflammation of the arachnoid, one of the membranes that protect the spinal cord; and

WHEREAS, Arachnoiditis causes inflammation which impairs the function of the spinal nerves, including the afferent and efferent nerve pathways; and

WHEREAS, Arachnoiditis knows no age limit, and if left unrecognized, untreated, or mistreated, can lead to a variety of symptoms that may result in devastating consequences which can impair the person's ability to function independently to meet their activities of daily living, employment, and lead to total disability; and

WHEREAS, the onset of Arachnoiditis can be associated with the use of interventional anesthesia procedures, neurotoxic drugs including unregulated compounded drugs, spinal surgeries, and infections involving the arachnoid membrane; and

WHEREAS, it can be difficult to detect, diagnose, treat and provide for the integrated care needs of affected persons; and

WHEREAS, prevention of this injury is paramount, and early diagnosis and intervention is crucial, and correct aggressive treatment by qualified medical professional can lead to a positive results before Arachnoiditis progresses and treatment becomes increasingly difficult; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bill Haslam, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim July, 2015 as

Frachnoiditis Awareness Month

in Tennessee and encourage all citizens to join me in this worthy observance.
